Hotel Gaston in the 17th arrondissement of Paris plays the card of artistic creation. The owners, George Bonneau and Patrick Hayat, have entrusted their six-storey building to the artists collective of Splendens Factory. Each level its style, such was the equation of their work. If the 43 rooms of modest size are very comfortable: quality bedding, Wifi..., it is the common areas that have sharpened the imagination of designers. Colorful graffittis, brutal paintings, photos, collages, comics or kinetic patterns monopolize the corridors and stairwells of each level. There is no restaurant but the common room on the ground floor hosts the breakfast buffet in a very friendly way with delicacies from Gontran Cherrier's bakery. The room rate is reasonable for intramural Paris: around 100€.
